Heather Rankin is a singer, songwriter, actor, and member of the 6X Juno Award-winning group The Rankin Family. As a solo artist, she has released two albums, *A Fine Line* (ECMA/Juno Nom.) and *Imagine* (ECMA Nom.). She has brought her solo show to venues across Canada, headlined the Lunenburg Folk Harbour Festival, hosted Songwriters' Circles at ECMA Week and Nova Scotia SummerFest, and performed with the Cape Breton Orchestra at Celtic Colours, Symphony Nova Scotia, and the Calgary Philharmonic. Since 2018, Heather has performed with Bette MacDonald, Lucy MacNeil, and Jenn Sheppard in *Island Girls*, a comedic and musical salute to Cape Breton. Named a Canada 150 Ambassador in 2017, she co-wrote "*River of Nations*" during the Canada C3 Expedition. Heather has recorded and performed with artists such as The Chieftains, Johnny Reid, and Carly Simon, and continues to celebrate Cape Breton's musical heritage.

Guy Davis is a two-time Grammy nominee for Best Traditional Blues, as well as a musician, actor, author, and songwriter. He blends roots, blues, folk, rock, rap, spoken word, and world music to address social injustice and life's struggles, with storytelling that is raw and real. His songs, such as "God's Gonna Make Things Over", "Welcome to My World", and "Got Your Letter In My Pocket", reflect his theatrical background and powerful lyricism. Guy has won the Keeping The Blues Alive Award and earned nearly two dozen nominations from The Blues Foundation, including Best Acoustic Album, Best Acoustic Artist, and Best Instrumentalist. He's been featured in publications including The New York Times, Village Voice, Boston Globe, Blues Magazine, and on NPR and Sirius. Guy proudly says: *"There is no tale so tall that I cannot tell it, nor song so sweet that I cannot sing it."*

"My favourite part of my shows is breaking the barrier between myself and the audience. I always go into the crowd and allow everyone to become a part of the performance", says Travis.



After nearly two decades in the music industry, Don Amero finds himself following his heart rather than rebranding. Armed with new material, he's pushing the boundaries of country music by blending Americana, country, soul, and pop. Amero now sees himself working in the service industry, aiming to make music with a purpose. His 2022 EP *Nothing Is Meaningless* earned a CCMA nomination, and he authored a children's book, *These Roots of Love*.

His 'Through The Fire' podcast, Indigenous advocacy, and mentorship also reflect this attitude of service. Amero plans to release a series of six-song EPs starting in 2025, focusing on personal stories and various sonic qualities to let his voice shine. Influenced by a range of genres, from country to hip-hop, Amero is determined to avoid repetition, embrace growth, and create music that feels like freedom, while balancing fatherhood and family life with his evolving artistic journey.

This holiday season, Pro Coro Canada joins forces with Vocal Collective for *A Christmas Carol*—a powerful, musical retelling of the classic story, featuring over 60 performers on stage under the direction of conductor Michael Zaugg.

Founded in 1981 by Michel Marc Gervais, Pro Coro Canada is one of Canada's premier professional chamber choirs, known for artistic excellence and bold programming. Based in Edmonton, the 24-voice ensemble has been shaped by conductors including Gervais, Anders Eby (Sweden), Søren Hansen (Denmark), and Richard Sparks (USA). Since 2012, Michael Zaugg has served as Artistic Director. The choir has performed across Canada and commissioned and premiered over 80 works in the last 5 years. Pro Coro also produced the Edmonton International Choral Festival, served on faculty at the Banff Centre, and runs a composer-in-residence program. In 2020, it received Choral Canada's Innovation Award for its impact on Canadian choral music.



Jake's Gift is a surprisingly funny drama that tells the story of a Canadian WW2 veteran's reluctant return to Normandy, France, for the 60th anniversary of D-Day. While roaming the shores of Juno Beach, Jake encounters Isabelle, a precocious ten-year-old from the local village whose inquisitive nature and charm challenge the old soldier to confront some long-ignored ghosts – most notably, the wartime death of his eldest brother, Chester, a once promising young musician. At its heart, *Jake's Gift* is about the legacy of remembrance and makes personal the story behind one soldier's grave. Since 2007, Juno Productions has toured this multi-award-winning play to over 265 communities across Canada including international stops in Washington State, Tiverton & Birmingham, England, and to Normandy, France, for the 70th, 73rd, and 75th anniversary of D-Day.

For nearly two decades, Delhi 2 Dublin has led South Asian fusion music, pioneering “Subcontinental Pop”—a high-energy blend of Bhangra, electronic, hip-hop, reggae, and Celtic sounds. As their 20th anniversary nears in 2026, the band is re-energized, creating new music for the first time in six years. Founders Sanjay Seran and Ravi Binning push the band’s sound to new heights, joined by longtime violinist Serena Eades and newcomer Kal Mattu (producer, keyboardist, tabla player), who brings fresh vibrancy. From a one-night collaboration at Vancouver’s Celtic Fest to major stages like Glastonbury, Burning Man, and Electric Forest, Delhi 2 Dublin has earned a global reputation for “90 minutes of freebasing joy.” With acclaimed albums like *Planet Electric*, *Turn Up The Stereo*, and *We Got This*—their first to hit commercial radio—the band continues breaking boundaries. With new music and a booming festival season, Delhi 2 Dublin is just getting started.




